## Hi, I'm Josh,

And I am thankful to represent our portion of Lower Georgia Avenue. The community elected me to serve a two year term for 1E06 representing ~2,000 people. Our district is bounded by Georgia and Sherman from east to west and Fairmont to Barry from north to south, including the Howard Plaza Towers.

- **Middle School Survey!**  
The new school on Euclid is asking for community feedback, and I need your help! Reply to the survey at [anc1e06.com/survey](http://anc1e06.com/survey) to make your voice heard!
- **Rat Abatement**  
Neighbors continue to see an uptick of rats in the area. DOH treated many yards for rats, but we didn't have all neighbors signed on for treatment. DOH will come out again, but we need more neighbors signed on. Text/email me if you'd like to sign onto the petition.

- **Banneker Dog Park**  
In March, we passed a resolution in favor of a dog park in the SE corner of Banneker Park. We have been working with DPR who is in favor of the park location. Next step is working with Council on funding.
- **Better Bus Initiative**  
WMATA is implementing new bus routes across the city starting June 29. This will generally help rebalance service and reduce transit times. The 70/79 routes will become the D40/D4X routes.
- **Fixed Parking Sign**  
I worked with DDOT to remove an erroneous no parking sign, bringing 5 spaces back to Sherman

### What are ANC's?

ANCs are your voice in DC government for matters that affect our neighborhood, such as housing/zoning, transportation, business licenses, and public amenities.

DC voters elect 345 unpaid commissioners to 2-year terms, with Georgia Ave's 1E Commission consisting of 7 single-member districts. ANC 1E is brand new as of Jan 2023.
